

2007 IAVAT Dairy Foods Career Development Event

- NO talking during the Dairy Foods CDE
- Participants use the same Scantron sheet for the entire event

Directions to participants

1. Each participant should have a clipboard and two pencils. The Scantron sheet should be placed on the clipboard, with the information listed below filled out prior to the beginning of the contest.
2. Write in the Team Name
3. Fill in the Team/School ID: it is your chapter number, just drop the IL
4. Fill in the Contestant's Full Name
5. Fill in Codes
 - a) 1 for the "Sheet"
 - b) 1 for the "Test"
 - b) 1 for the "Team"
 - c) contestant number is filled in student (assigned at registration)

6. There will be 8 Classes/Parts to the Dairy Foods CDE. Use the front of the Scantron sheet for Classes 1-4. Class 5, Part I & II, and the Written Test should be placed on the back of the sheet. The name associated with each class/part as well as the location of the class/part are listed below.

7. The CDE will begin with instructions followed by the team event in the Stock Pavilion, and then each group will go to AESB to their assigned room. Participants will have 13 minutes to complete each class. There will be 2 minutes between each class.
8. Please be aware of the following:
 - **Answers for the "Team Problem" are to be filled in on Student 1's Scantron sheet only. Student 2 through 5 should leave the area blank.**
 - The team event will be multiple choice and the answers will go on the back of the Scantron sheet marked as "Part II".
 - Dairy versus Non-dairy answers will go on the back of the Scantron sheet marked as "Part I Problem Solving".
 - For the **Team Event, Written Test**, and all other areas that apply- leave all numbers blank where there are no questions or answers. Example- there is 20 questions for the written test but there are 50 blanks on the sheet. Answer 1 through 20 and leave 21 through 50 blank.
 - Class 5- Scoring and Defects of Milker Unit Heads. A perfect score is assigned as 4 with a ½ point deduction for each defect.
 - Flashlights will be provided to examine the Milker Unit Heads.
